



## **IMPORTANT UPDATE**

## Effective December 2024, the Illinois Clean Energy Community Foundation Has Ceased Operations

Founded in 1999, the Illinois Clean Energy Community Foundation supported programs that improved energy efficiency, advanced the development and use of renewable energy resources, and protected natural areas and wildlife habitat in communities across Illinois. The Foundation was proud of the positive impact it had over it's 25 year history. All approved grants were funded subject to the provisions of the grant agreement.

## FOUNDATION ACCOMPLISHMENTS

Since its founding in 1999, excluding its final grant of \$47.1 million to Prairie State Conservation Coalition, the Illinois Clean Energy Community Foundation awarded \$323.2 million in program grants to Illinois schools, municipalities, local government agencies and nonprofit organizations. Grants supported activities in 101 of the 102 counties in Illinois.
